### **NOTES**

#### Privacy

The *Information Act 2002* requires you to supply your name and an address for correspondence, as well as your reasons for making the complaint. Additional contact details will assist the Information Commissioner to deal with your complaint. Some personal information may have to be disclosed to others in order to deal with your complaint. Personal information may also be disclosed in a decision or order in relation to the complaint, or in any court proceedings relating to the complaint. Reasons for decision finalising complaints are likely to be published. Every effort will be made to limit disclosure to what is necessary in the case. If you want to discuss privacy further you can call the Office of the Information Commissioner.
