# Information Privacy Principles (IPPs)

## The IPPs state:

- Only collect the personal information you need
- Tell your client why the information is needed and how it will be used
- Only use personal information for the purpose it was collected or as permitted by law. If you are unsure, ask to your Privacy Officer or Supervisor
- Keep personal records accurate and secure
